**Dr. Brenda Schick**

Dr. Schick studies the development of American Sign Language (ASL) and its relationship to cognition in Deaf children. Recent work has focused on the development of a Theory of Mind in Deaf children and how language skills predict its development.

She has published research on the acquisition of ASL in children, including the development of assessment materials. With Dr. Mary Pat Moeller, she has studied the development of sign systems designed to replicate English structure. She is the co-developer of the Educational Interpreter Performance Assessment (EIPA), a tool designed to evaluate the skills of interpreters in public schools, currently used in about twenty-five states. She is the co-developer of a sign language curriculum designed for parents, *Sign With Me*, as well as a series of children's books that have been translated into ASL by Deaf adults and children, *Read With Me*.

She has served as the school board president for a bilingual charter school for Deaf children in metro Denver. She was a classroom teacher for Deaf children for six years and is a former RID-certified interpreter. In addition, she is a CODA, having grown up in a Deaf family.

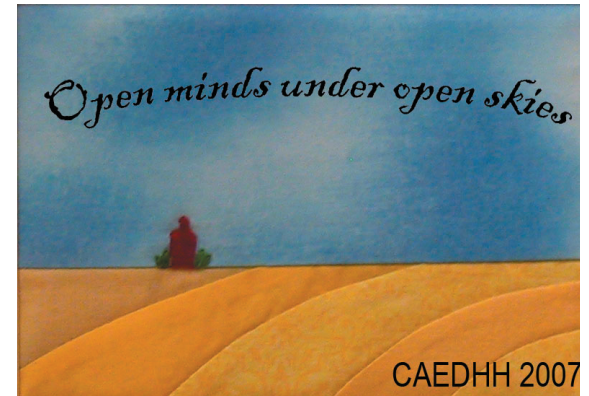
